Management Report of Fund Performance for the period ended June 30, 2020

This semi-annual management report of fund performance contains financial highlights but does not contain the complete semi-annual or annual financial statements of the investment fund. RESULTS OF OPERATIONS

The Fund's net assets decreased by \$30.2 million to \$459.1 million from December 31, 2019 to June 30, 2020. The Fund had net sales of \$55.4 million for the period. The Fund paid distributions totalling \$1.9 million while the portfolio's performance decreased assets by \$83.7 million. Series A units returned -19.0% after fees and expenses for the six-month period ended June 30, 2020. Over the same time period, the Fund's benchmark returned -7.5%. The benchmark is the S&P/TSX Composite Total Return Index (the Benchmark).

The performance of the Fund's other Series is substantially similar to that of Series A units, except for differences in the structure of fees and expenses. For the returns of the Fund's other Series, please refer to the "Past Performance" section.

The following commentary pertains to the results of operations of the Canadian Equity Alpha Corporate Class (Underlying Fund).

Following a sharp correction which started in February and bottomed in late March caused by the worldwide outbreak of COVID-19 and the lockdowns that followed, global equity markets began to climb back in April, May, and June, partly on the back of record amounts of stimulus from governments and central banks, and growing optimism on vaccine and treatment options. We continue to monitor all COVID-19 developments closely as they will likely have a material impact on future market performance.

Information technology and materials dominated Canadian market performance during the first six months of the year. It was a different story for most other sectors which suffered steep declines.

Since we began managing the Underlying Fund on May 15, 2020, consumer discretionary, financials, and information technology were the largest contributors to Underlying Fund performance. The largest detractor of relative performance since we began managing the Underlying Fund came from an underweight exposure to the financials sector.

The largest individual contributors to performance since we began managing the Underlying Fund were Canadian Tire Corp., Lowe's Companies Inc., and Apple Inc. The largest individual detractors from performance were Suncor Energy Inc., Fiserv Inc., and Enbridge Inc.

Since we began managing the Underlying Fund, new investments were made in Booking Holdings Inc. and Automatic Data Processing. Booking Holdings is the world leader in online travel. Automatic Data Processing is a global provider of business outsourcing solutions including human resources, payroll, and tax.

The Underlying Fund sold out of iA Financial Corp Inc., KLA Corp., and Pason Systems Inc. IA Financial Corp Inc. operates as an insurance and wealth management company.

KLA Corp. produces and distributes semi-conductors. Pason Systems Inc. provides rental oilfield instrumentation systems that are designed and manufactured for use on land-based drilling and service rigs. All three eliminations were done so in favour of more attractive investment opportunities in our view.

Overall, the Fund underperformed its benchmark.

RECENT DEVELOPMENTS

When we assumed management responsibilities of the Underlying Fund, the Canadian content minimum was moved from 70% to 51%. We continue to source high-quality investment ideas that are aligned with the mandate of the Underlying Fund. We will continue to closely monitor macro-economic developments that could have an impact on the Underlying Fund's holdings.

Effective April 3, 2020, Stuart Hensman resigned as a member of the Independent Review Committee (IRC) of CI Funds and effective April 3, 2020, Donna Toth was appointed as a member of the IRC.

Portfolio Sub-Advisor

Effective May 15, 2020, Harbour Advisors, a division of CI Investments Inc. replaced QV Investors Inc. as Portfolio Sub-Advisor to the Fund.

RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

Manager, Portfolio Advisor, Trustee and Registrar

CI Investments Inc. is the Manager, Portfolio Advisor, Trustee and Registrar of the Fund. CI Investments Inc. is a subsidiary of CI Financial Corp. The Manager, in consideration for management fees, provides management services required in the day-to-day operations of the Fund. The Manager bears all of the operating expenses of the Fund (other than taxes, borrowing costs and new governmental fees) in return for an administration fee.

The Manager received \$2.0 million in management fees and \$0.3 million in administration fees for the period.

Management Fees

Approximately 23% of total management fees were used to pay for sales and trailing commissions. The remaining 77% of management fees were used to pay for investment management and other general administration.

Related Fund Trading

Related fund trading occurs when a Fund purchases or sells units/shares of another Fund managed by the Manager. During the period ended June 30, 2020, the Fund engaged in related fund trading or held position(s) in related fund(s) at the end of the period.

Principal Distributor

The Manager has the exclusive right to arrange for the distribution of units of the Fund. Pursuant to a series of agreements, the right to distribute such units has been granted, on a collective basis, to the following dealers, each of which is an affiliate of the Manager.

Independent Review Committee

The Fund has standing instructions from the Fund's IRC with respect to the following related party transactions:

- trades in securities of CI Financial Corp.; and
- purchases or sales of securities of an issuer from or to another investment fund managed by the Manager.

The applicable standing instructions require, amongst others, that related party transactions be conducted in accordance with the Manager's policies and procedures and applicable law and that the Manager advise the IRC of any material breach of such policies. The standing instructions also require that investment decisions in respect of related party transactions (a) are free from any influence by an entity related to the Manager and without taking into account any consideration relevant to an entity related to the Manager; (b) represent the business judgment of the Manager uninfluenced by considerations other than the best interests of the Fund; (c) are made in compliance

with the Manager's policies and procedures; and (d) achieve a fair and reasonable result for the Fund. Transactions made by the Manager under the standing instructions are subsequently reviewed by the IRC on a quarterly basis to monitor compliance.

The Fund relied on the IRC's standing instructions regarding related party transactions during this reporting period.

Except as otherwise noted above, the Fund was not a party to any related party transactions during the period ended June 30, 2020.

(2) Management expense ratio is calculated based on expenses charged to the Fund (excluding commissions and other portfolio transaction costs) and is expressed as an annualized percentage of daily average net assets for the period, including the Fund's proportionate share of any underlying fund(s) expenses, if applicable. The Effective HST tax rate is calculated using the attribution percentage for each province based on unitholder residency and can be different from 13%.

(3) The trading expense ratio represents total commissions and other portfolio transaction costs expressed as an annualized percentage of daily average net assets during the period, including the Fund's proportionate share of such expenses of any underlying fund(s), if applicable.

(4) The Fund's portfolio turnover rate indicates how actively the Fund's portfolio advisor manages its portfolio investments. A portfolio turnover rate of 100% is equivalent to the Fund buying and selling all of the securities in its portfolio once in the course of the fiscal period. The higher a Fund's portfolio turnover rate in a period, the greater the trading costs payable by the Fund in the period, and the greater the chance of an investor receiving taxable capital gains in the period. There is not necessarily a relationship between a higher turnover rate and the performance of a Fund. Portfolio turnover rate is calculated by dividing the lesser of the cost of purchases and the proceeds of sales of portfolio securities for the period, and excluding cash and short-term investments maturing in less than one year, and before assets acquired from a merger, if applicable, by the average of the monthly fair value of investments during the period.

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
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PAST PERFORMANCE
