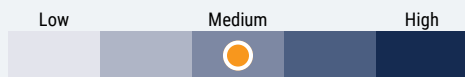

## Risk rating<sup>2</sup>



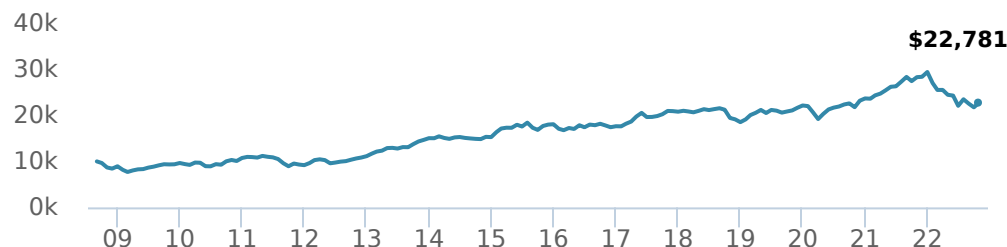

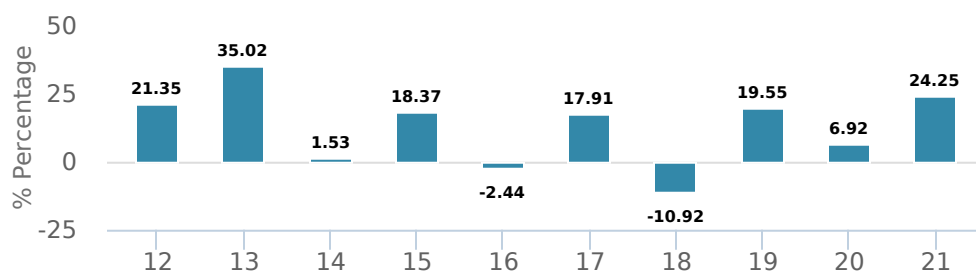
